OUTDOOR FACILITIES

To accommodate the requirements of varsity and junior varsity, middle school and intramural sports, the 30-acre outdoor athletic complex will include six grass playing fields for both practice and games, and two lighted turf fields.

Two softball diamonds will also be constructed and a baseball practice field, with baseball games played at the nearby Sports at the Beach complex. In time, the sports facility will add a track and tennis courts.

INDOOR FACILITIES

Sussex Academy's world-class gymnasium will host basketball and volleyball contests, and a host of intramural activities.

Attractive new, fully-equipped locker rooms exist for girls and boys teams and visitors. Access to the playing fields and a weight training room can be made from either locker room.

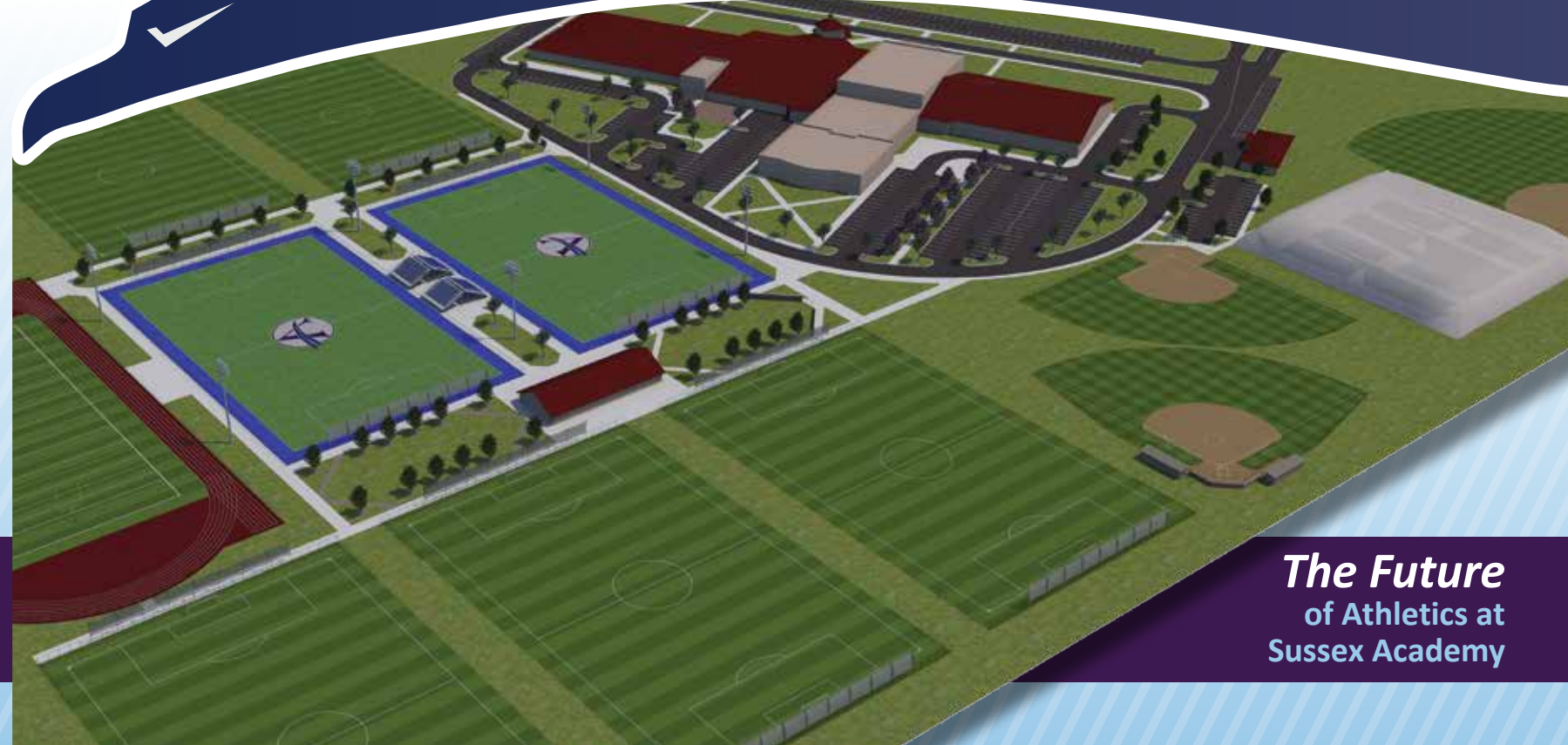
In time, an aquatic center will also be constructed.

Top-quality, experienced coaches are recruited, some from the school's own pool of talented instructors.

At this time, there are no additional fees required for students to participate in sports at Sussex Academy. Student athletes must meet the academic and eligibility requirements specified by the DIAA. Eighth grade students gain a possible 5th year of athletic eligibility at Sussex Academy.*

*8th graders participating in high school sports must have attended Sussex Academy in 7th grade.

The school's mascot is the Seahawk, or osprey, a bird of prey known for its speed, vision and agility, as well as its strong loyalty to family.
